

If you want a copy of the 2007-08 Wisconsin Statutes when they are published in 2009, you will need to ask for a set.



2007 Wisconsin Act 71 which was effective on March 25, 2008, amended Sec. 35.84, Wis. Stats. to delete the requirements of automatic distribution of the revised statute books to Town, Village, City and County clerks along with State Representatives, County Board Chairpersons, Sheriffs, County Corporation Counsel, Registers of Deeds, Coroners/ Medical Examiners, County Treasurers, County Surveyors, County Human Services/Social Services Directors and County Veterans' Service Officers. In order to receive a set of revised statutes every two years, these officers must make written application to the Wisconsin Department of Administration.

When the revised statutes become available for circulation, written application can be sent to:
